

**Quad City Area Dog Parks
(Not all inclusive)**

1. Hasselroth Dog Park (Public)

- a) Milan, IL (Quad Cities)
78th Avenue West (Andalusia Road)
- b) Formal dog park
- c) 1 acre?
- d) Double gate
- e) benches, garbage cans, shade, water fountain, poop bags, picnic tables, fake hydrants
- f) mostly grass, some concrete
- g) no separate areas
- h) park hours (sunrise to sunset), plenty of parking
- l) quick access to interstate, also it is located directly next to another park with a big kids play area

2. Green Valley Dog Park (Public)

- a) Moline, IL
6009 50th Ave. (Across the road from Green Valley Sports Complex)
- b) Formal Dog Park
- c) 1 acre plus
- d) benches, fencing, water service available for both animals and people, dispensers for clean-up, fake fire hydrants
- e) Grass Surface
- f) Shade available with plenty of room to run
- g) Park hours (sunrise to sunset)

3. Crow Creek Dog Park (Public)

- a) Bettendorf, Iowa
Located inside Crow Creek Park, just south of 53rd Street on the east side of Devil's Glen Road.
- b) Formal, legal dog park
- c) Approximately 5 acres, divided in half (only half is open at a time, allowing grass to "recover" in other half).
- d) 6', vinyl-coated, chain link fencing
- e) Double gates on north and south sides of park

- f) Amenities O' Plenty! Garbage cans and poo bags provided at gates and in middle of each side. Park benches & small "escape" benches. Huge oak trees for shade, dual people/dog drinking fountains just outside both gates (turned off in the winter). Park restrooms within very easy walking distance. There are also developed walking trails through the adjacent, wooded parts of the park (dogs on-leash, of course), including a quarry pond; the whole area is a major photo-op!
- g) Grass surface, with regular tree debris (leaves, twigs, acorns)
- h) Currently, no separate area for small or aggressive dogs, but it has been strongly suggested to the city's parks department.
- i) Hours are "dawn to dusk" with generous, graveled parking on both north and south sides of park.
- j) This dog park was completed and opened in late September 2007. Located inside Crow Creek Park, just south of 53rd Street on the east side of Devil's Glen Road. Take a left once you're inside the main entrance; the dog park will be on your right. Rules are clearly posted at the gates, if not always followed; the city is working on forming a volunteer patrol squad.

4. Centennial Dog Park (Public)

- a) Davenport, Iowa
315 S. Marquette Street
- b) Fenced in area
- c) benches, trees, and agility equipment provided
- c) Park Hours (sunrise to sunset)

5. C.M. Dog Park (Private)

- a) Davenport, Iowa
210th St (located just 10 minutes off of Interstate 80 and Interstate 280 just outside of Davenport)
- b) Fully enclosed area
- c) Park has an open area for free play, trees for shade, and agility equipment for fun and a centrally located picnic area to sit and enjoy watching your pet play.
